RPOF Names Director of Congressional Affairs

Tallahassee—Republican Party of Florida Chairman Jim Greer today appointed Russell Peck to serve as the RPOF’s Director of Congressional Affairs. The Chairman announced the creation of the new position, aimed at maximizing coordination with Florida’s Republican Congressional Delegation.

“I am happy to announce that the RPOF has created a new position to focus fulltime on helping our incumbent members in Florida get reelected to Congress, as well as providing resources to our challenger candidates,” said RPOF Chairman Greer. “Russell Peck, our new Director of Congressional Affairs, brings several cycles of campaign experience in local, state and federal elections and will serve as a great asset to our team.”

Russell Peck previously served as the Southwest Florida Field Director for Bush-Cheney ’04, Inc., and as the Florida Director of Voter Registration and Statewide Field Director for the Republican Party of Florida and the Republican National Committee during the 2006 election cycle. He later served as the Political Director for Clay Shaw for Congress and as the Florida Organizational Director for John McCain 2008, Inc. in early 2007. Peck has also served on the 55th Presidential Inaugural Committee, at the United States Department of Labor, on the Crist-Kottkamp Transition Team and as an account manager with Enwright Consulting Group, Inc.

“The Republican Party of Florida has shown that we are serious about winning Congressional elections,” concluded Greer. “This position will allow the RPOF to provide further support for Florida’s Congressional Delegation and refocus our efforts on behalf of Republican Congressional candidates.”
